<b>Comments</b>	<p>During the testing of this product, the dress was found not compliant with EN 14682:2007: Cords &amp; Drawstrings on Children's Clothing as the product had drawstrings that are not attached to the apparel, and had knots at the free ends. Apparel intended for young children (birth to age 7 years) shall not be designed, manufactured or supplied with drawstrings, or functional cords in the head, neck or upper chest area. Drawstrings (including the toggle) at the crotch area were found to hang below the lower edge of the apparel, and did not lie flat when tightened.</p> <p>No reports of incidents or injuries related to the use of this product have been received to date.</p>
