Subject: Registration of Mains Socket Outlets and Portable Socket-Outlets incorporated with type C

USB port(s) under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Registration Scheme

Dear Registered Suppliers,

Under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Registration Scheme (CPS Scheme), 33 categories of household electrical, electronic and gas appliances and accessories are classified as Controlled Goods. Controlled Goods are required to be tested and certified to specified safety standards, registered with Enterprise Singapore, and affixed with the Safety Mark before they can be supplied in Singapore. Enterprise Singapore wishes to inform that mains socket outlets and portable socket-outlets incorporated with type C USB port(s), can be tested and certified for registration under the CPS scheme. The applicable safety standards are as follows:

No	Controlled Goods	Minimum edition of safety standard
1	3-pin 13-amp mains socket-outlets incorporated with type C USB port(s)	SS 145 Part 2: 2018 and IEC 60950-1: 2001 <u>or</u> IEC 62368-1: 2014
2	3-pin Portable socket-outlet (PSO) incorporated with type C USB port(s)	SS 145 Part 2: 2018 and IEC 60950-1: 2001 <u>or</u> IEC 62368-1: 2014

The minimum edition of the safety standards mentioned in the table above are applicable with immediate effect from the date of this circular.

If you intend to supply the above products in Singapore, do approach our Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) for the testing, certification and registration of the Controlled Goods for the CPS scheme.
