Subject: Change in risk categorisation for Lamp Control Gears under the Consumer Protection (Safety

Requirements) Registration Scheme

Dear Registered Suppliers,

This circular is to inform Registered Suppliers on the change in risk categorisation for Lamp Control Gears regulated under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Registration Scheme (CPS Scheme).

Under the CPS Scheme, 33 categories of household electrical, electronic and gas appliances and accessories are classified as Controlled Goods. Controlled Goods are required to be tested and certified to specified safety standards, registered with Enterprise Singapore, and affixed with the Safety Mark before they can be supplied in Singapore. Lamp Control Gears (including LED Drivers) are one of the categories of Controlled Goods. More information about the CPS Scheme is available at:

Enterprise Singapore wishes to inform that, for the purpose of testing and certification under the CPS scheme, the risk level for Lamp Control Gears will be revised from the **high risk** to **medium risk** category.

No	Controlled Goods	Revised Risk Level
1	Lamp Control Gears	Medium Risk

When carrying out re-certification of Controlled Goods in the **medium risk** category, if there are no other technical changes to the product, Registered Suppliers will not need to provide a valid new test report dated within 3 years from date of renewal.

The change is effective immediately from the date of this circular.
