Dear Designated Conformity Assessment Bodies ('CAB'),

This circular is to inform you that the Consumer Product Safety Office¹ ('CPSO') has revised the Conditions of Designation (formerly known as the General Terms and Conditions of Designation), which has been issued to CABs upon their successful designation under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations ('CPSR').

2. The revised Conditions of Designation will only take effect when you complete your next designation renewal (i.e., your current designation will still be based on the General Terms and Conditions issued during your last designation renewal). In the meantime, all CABs are to be familiarised with the revised Conditions of Designation. The revised Conditions of Designation has been updated in Appendices C and D of the Conformity Assessment Information Booklet, which can be found at:

3. Together with the above update, the booklet has also been generally revised as of 1st November 2021 to be more relevant and succinct. Please refer to Appendix G of the booklet for a summary of the main changes.
