About the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations

Suppliers of household products classified as Controlled Goods¹ under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations (CPSR), must ensure products are typetested, certified to meet specified safety standards, registered with Enterprise Singapore, and affixed with a SAFETY Mark before they can be sold in Singapore.

To ensure the safety of these Controlled Goods for consumers, Enterprise Singapore administers the CPSR, conducts regular checks on suppliers and retailers, and carries out briefings to educate the suppliers and retailers of the requirements.

Any person found guilty of selling unregistered Controlled Goods, is liable upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding S\$10,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or both.
