DO YOUR HOMEWORK

Check out past buyers' feedback, seller ratings, and independent product reviews to make sure no safety hazards or reliability issues exist.

A quick search online can often help reveal products that have been recalled by the manufacturer or had its sale stopped by regulatory bodies over safety issues. You can also visit **qo.qov.sq/recalls** for product recalls and notices.
