<b>Comments</b>	<p>During the testing of this sample, it was found that the product did not comply with the safety requirements for strollers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• EN 1888 (2012): Child care articles – Wheeled child conveyances – Safety requirements and test methods</li></ul> <p>The restraint system and fasteners were not reliable and the test mass fell out during testing.</p> <p>The tether strap was found to be too long and is an entanglement hazard.</p> <p>The product failed to meet stability requirements and overturned during testing.</p> <p>The product broke when it was used over irregular test surfaces.</p> <p>The product and its packaging do not have information provided in English.</p> <p>No report of incident or injury related to the use of this product has been received to date.</p>
