Comments	<ul> <li>During the testing of this sample, it was found that the product did not comply with the safety requirements for strollers: <ul> <li>EN 1888 (2012): Child care articles – Wheeled child conveyances – Safety requirements and test methods</li> </ul> </li> <li>The restraint system and fasteners were not reliable and the test mass fell out during testing.</li> <li>Pinching points were found in multiple areas of the product.</li> <li>The parking devices cannot be simultaneously engaged with a single action on multiple wheels.</li> <li>The product failed to meet stability requirements and overturned during testing.</li> <li>The product broke when it was used over irregular test surfaces.</li> <li>The product and its packaging do not have information provided in English.</li> <li>No report of incident or injury related to the use of this product has been received to date.</li> </ul>
