Dell recalls hybrid power adaptor

Dell has announced a voluntary recall of their hybrid power adaptors that are sold with power banks. The adaptor is designed to be disconnected from the power bank via release tabs. The adaptor casing can break and detach, exposing the internal components and posing an electric shock hazard to users.

The affected adaptors were manufactured from January 2017 through March 2017 and can be used separately from the power bank while connected to a power outlet. The adaptors have the following manufacture code – “CN-05G53P – LOC00 – XXX – XXXX – AXX” printed on the back of the unit, where “X represents a number. A full listing of the recalled adaptor manufacture codes included in the recall is listed on www.dellproduct.com.

Consumers that own the affected adaptors are advised to stop using them immediately and contact Dell for instructions on receiving a free replacement adaptor.
