We understand that CPSO may withdraw exemptions at their discretion.

We undertake to: -

- 1. Ensure that units of the exempted Controlled Goods will not be sold or otherwise supplied in Singapore, and to register the Controlled Good prior to any sale or supply.
- 2. Take full responsibility for ensuring the safe use of the exempted Controlled Good and hold harmless and indemnify Enterprise Singapore in respect of any third-party claim, or any loss or damage, suffered as a result of the exempted Controlled Good.
- 3. Ensure that units of the exempted Controlled Goods are fitted with 3-pin mains plug registered under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations or 2-pin mains plug compliant to EN 50075 where applicable.
- 4. Not represent in any manner (whether through advertisement or oral representation) that the exempted Controlled Goods comply with safety requirements, or are safe for use in Singapore, before registering the Controlled Good.
- 5. Immediately cease any display or demonstration of exempted Controlled Good and remove units of the exempted Controlled Goods from contact with consumers if instructed to do so by CPSO.
