We understand that CPSO may withdraw exemptions at their discretion.

We undertake to: -

- 1. Ensure that units of the exempted Controlled Goods will not be sold or otherwise supplied in Singapore, and to register the Controlled Good prior to any sale or supply.
- 2. Take full responsibility for ensuring the safe use of the exempted Controlled Good and hold harmless and indemnify CPSO in respect of any third-party claim, or any loss or damage, suffered as a result of the exempted Controlled Good.
- 3. Ensure that units of the exempted Controlled Goods are fitted with 3-pin mains plug registered under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations or 2-pin mains plug compliant to EN 50075 where applicable.
- 4. Immediately cease any display or demonstration of exempted Controlled Good and remove units of the exempted Controlled Goods from contact with consumers if instructed to do so by CPSO.
